What about all the Prophets? - John the Baptist

Materials:

- white paper
- pencil or marker
- orange marker or scrap of orange construction paper
- scissors
- Single hole punch
- string/rope



Instructions:

- Place hand on white paper with fingers squeezed together and thumb extended as far as possible
- Trace around hand
- Use marker or pencil to draw on a small wing and eye
- Cut small orange beak and glue on thumb part below eye
- Cut out, punch hole and thread string or rope on for hanging

What About all the Prophets? - Abraham

Materials:

- Scissors
- Construction paper or cardstock
- Glue and/or tape
- Decorative materials (markers, crayons, stickers)
- Clear plastic container or small water bottles
- Oil
- Glitter
- Food coloring (optional)

Instructions:

- Decorate the jar with stickers and permanent markers.
- Add verses and captions (taped paper) to the outside of jar.
- Place a small amount of oil in the jar. Add food coloring drops if desired. Add water to almost fill the jar.
- Add glitter to the jar. Tightly screw the lid and shake all items together. Enjoy admiring the "galaxy jar" as a reminder of God's promises!

What about all the Prophets? - Miriam the Prophetess

Materials:

- 2 paper plates,
- A hole punch,
- Ribbon,
- Glitter,
- Glue,
- Coloring equipment.

Instructions:

- Decorate the paper plates.
- Place plates together. Use a hole punch to make holes around the outside.
- Tie plates together using ribbon or string.

What about all the Prophets? Elijah and Elisha

Materials:

- Cardboard tube (paper towel roll)
- Aluminum foil
- Red, orange, yellow tissue paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: Red/silver paint, markers

Instructions:

- **Decorate the Handle:** Paint or cover the cardboard tube with silver or red paper/paint to look like a torch handle.
- **Create the Flame Base:** Glue crumpled aluminum foil pieces around the top of the tube to form a base for the flame.
- **Assemble the Flame:** Layer red, orange, and yellow tissue paper, securing them in the middle with glue, then shape them into a flame.
- **Attach the Flame:** Insert the center of the tissue paper flame into the foil-covered top of the tube and let it dry.

What about all the Prophets? Enoch

Materials:

- scrapbook paper
- construction paper or cardstock
- pipe cleaner
- scissors
- glue
- hole punch
- markers

Instructions:

- On construction paper or cardstock, have child or you trace around the child's foot with or without shoes on. (pictured: child's shoe traced)
- Cut out (or have child cut if he/she is old enough) the foot shape. Glue it to scrapbook paper (if desired). This makes the flip flop a little stronger and allows you to cover any mistakes. Now cut around shape again.
- Using hole puncher, punch one hole closer to the side of the flip flop where the big toe would go. Then punch two more holes DIRECTLY across from one another further down.
- Fold pipe cleaner in half and thread the center through the top hole. Twist the pipe cleaner on the back of the shoe a bit and then fold down.
- Now you will thread the two remaining ends of the pipe cleaner into the other two holes. Turn flip flop over and again twist ends and then fold down so that they stay secure. You may want to use a little tape on the back to hold the ends.
