*The Life and Times of Daniel – Daniel's Humble Beginning*

### Materials:

- One paper towel tube (or two toilet paper rolls taped together) per child
- Construction paper or cardstock (various colors)
- Scissors
- Glue stick or tape (masking or colorful tape works well)
- Crayons, markers, or stickers for decoration

### Instructions:

- Cover the paper towel tube with construction paper.
- Have children color and use stickers to decorate the telescope.
- Remind the the children to always look to and pray to God, as Daniel did.

*The Life and Times of Daniel – The Three Faithful Men*

### Materials:

- printer
- paper
- scissors
- glue
- something to color with (B&W version)
- option 1: red, orange and yellow construction paper  
OR
- option 2: red or orange tissue paper  
OR
- option 3: kitchen sponges cut into rough triangular shapes and red or orange tempera paint

### Instructions - Basic Paper Craft:

- Color the pieces (as appropriate) and cut them out.
- Assemble the craft as follows:
  - use markers to color some flames inside the furnace (the large shape) or see the OPTIONS section for different ideas for making flames (in the photo above, I used the construction paper option)
  - glue the belts onto the bodies
  - glue the heads onto the bodies
  - glue the people into the furnace
  - glue the rock border on top of the whole thing (line the bottom edge of the rocks up with the bottom edge of the furnace).

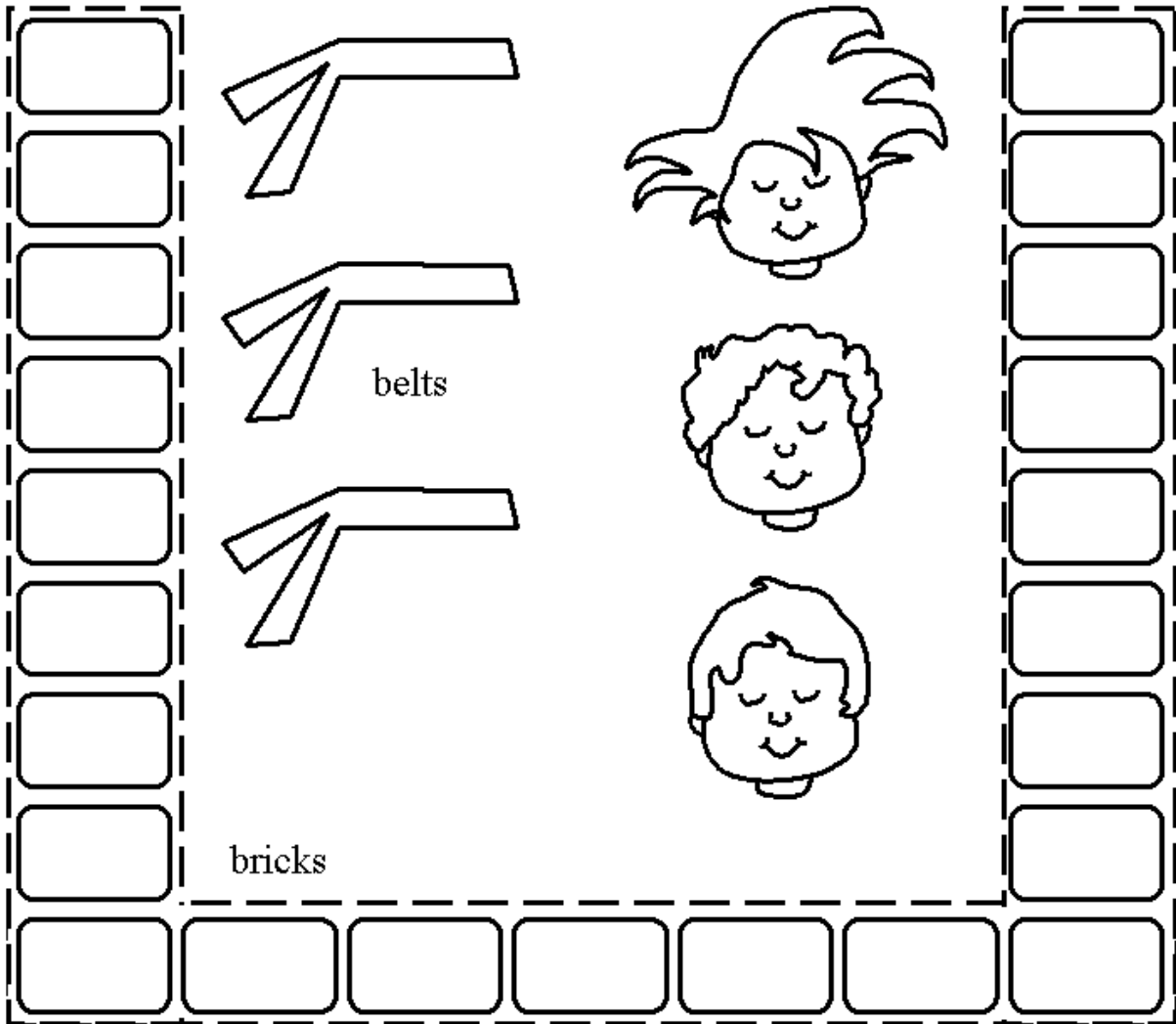
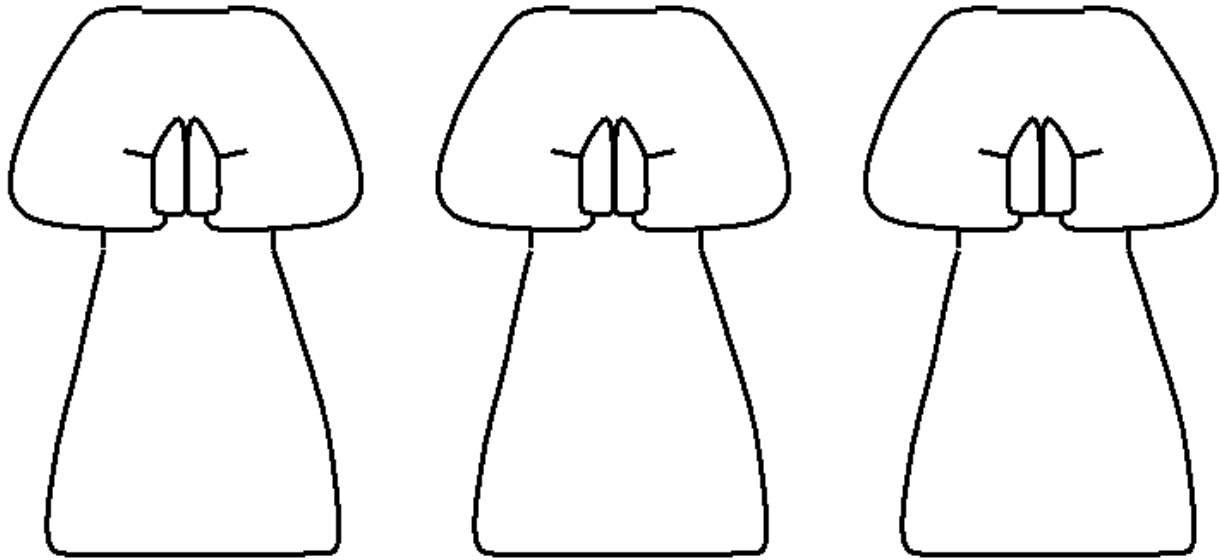
### Options - Construction Paper fire:

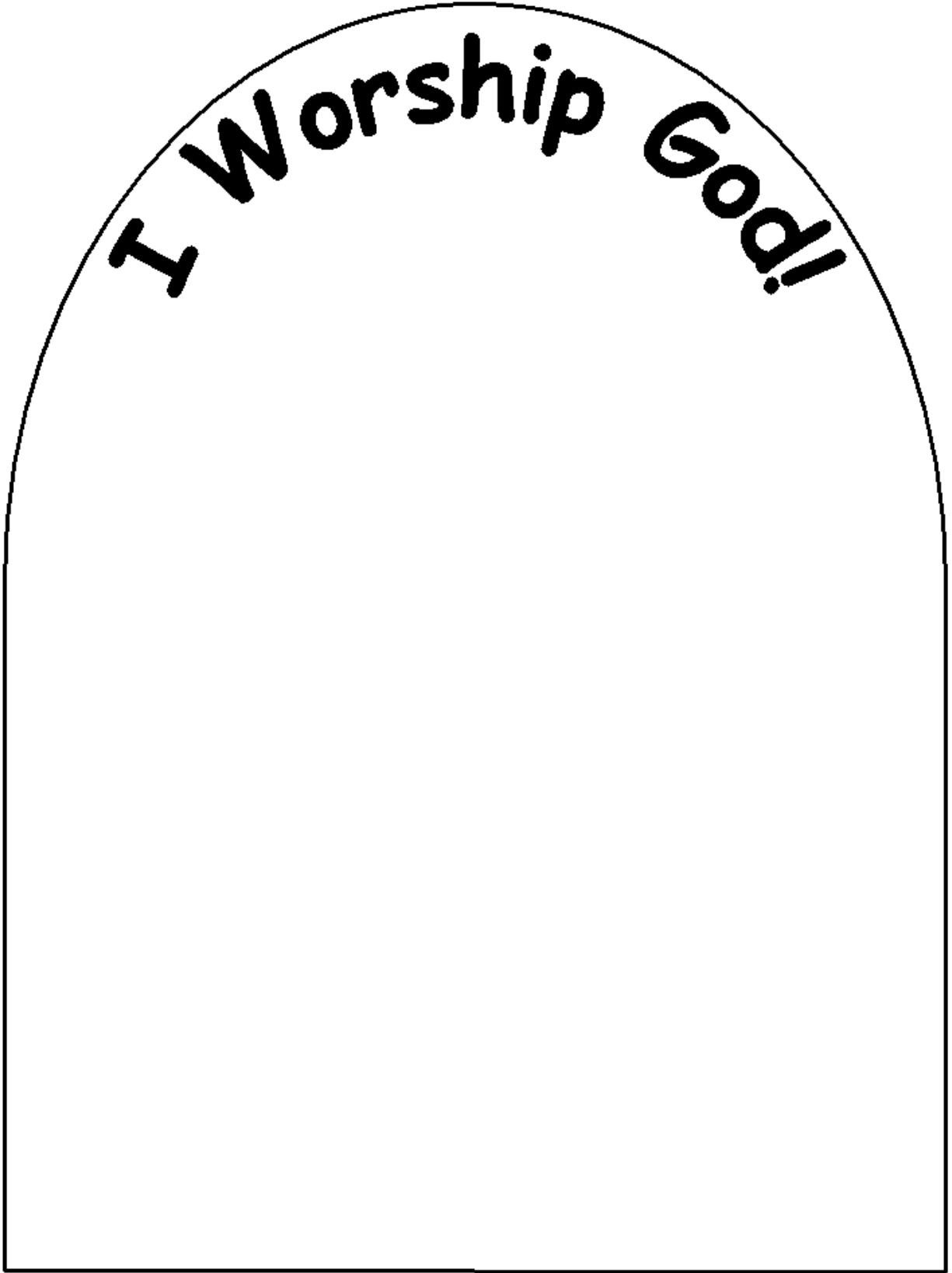
- tear pieces of red, orange and yellow into various sizes of "flame shapes" (rough triangles)
- Basic paper craft
  - glue the larger pieces onto the fiery furnace before assembly

- glue the smaller pieces on top of the people before gluing on the rock border
- 3D paper craft
  - glue the larger pieces onto the fiery furnace before assembly
  - make small squares of construction paper in various sizes (4"x1", 6"x1" and 8"x1") and glue them on the back of the smaller flames
  - glue the flames onto the craft so they're popping out at various levels

### **Options - Tissue Paper fire:**

- tear pieces of red and/or orange tissue paper into various sizes of "flame shapes" (rough triangles) -- really bright yellow can be used too, but a pastel yellow isn't colorful enough to work. Make sure you aren't using faded tissue paper.
- before you start gluing things together, lay the pieces of tissue paper all over the furnace and spritz with water with a spritz bottle or dab water on with a sponge
- set aside and let dry completely
- remove the dried pieces of tissue paper and throw away
- You should have dried remnants of the tissue paper showing inside your furnace (the tissue paper coloring should have stained the white paper).
- Assemble the craft as instructed in the directions

### Materials:

- Template
- White crayons
- Water color paints

### Instructions:

- BEFORE: Cut template on cut line. Write the phrase: Mene Mene Tekel Parsin using a white crayon in the box on the top half of the paper.
- Give each child a template (top half only with the words written in white crayon already completed)
- Have them color the framed section with watercolor paints
- The words written in white crayon should appear

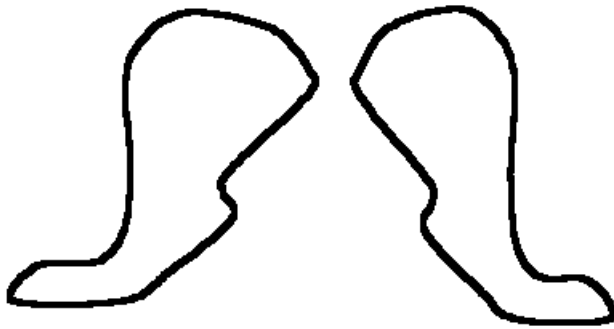
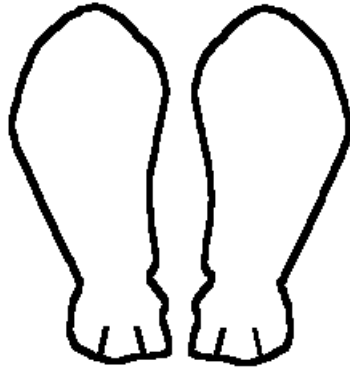
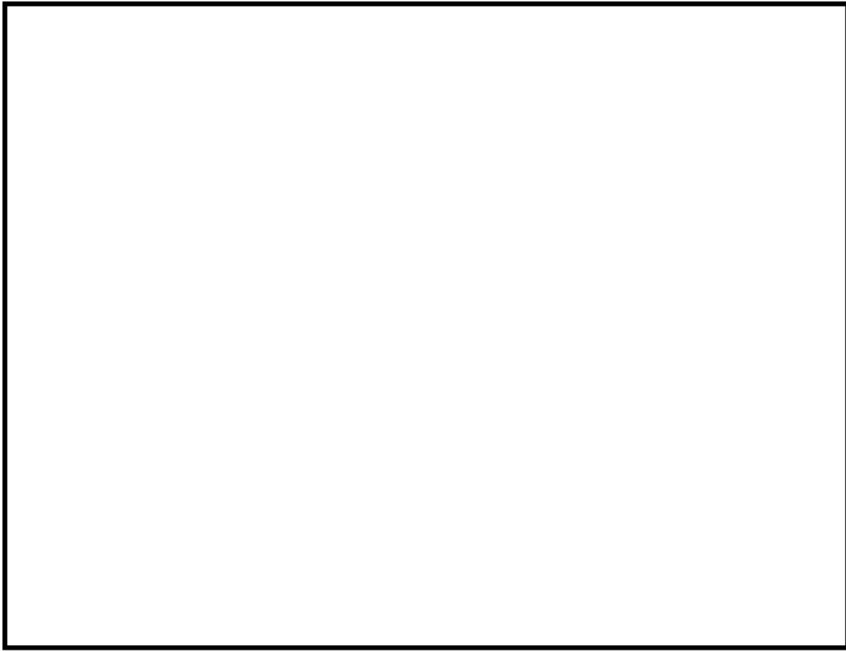
*The Life and Times of Daniel – Daniel and the Lion's Den*

### Materials:

- toilet paper roll or cardboard tube,
- printer,
- paper,
- scissors,
- glue,
- raffia or string,
- something to color with.

### Instructions:

- Color craft pieces.
- Cut out the pieces. This step may require adult assistance.
- Glue the large rectangle onto the toilet paper roll.
- Glue on the head, arms, legs and bravery medal.
- If you want to get a bit more creative, you can glue on some raffia, wool or string to form a tail in the back.

*The Life and Times of Daniel – King Neb's Dream*

### Materials:

- Template
- Crayons, markers, etc
- Scissors
- Glue
- Ping pong balls
- Yarn
- Popsicle sticks
- Plastic clear lids

### Instructions:

- First have children color the template of the statue
- Cut statue out in circle to fit on the lid
- Glue the cut-out to the top of the lid
- Glue the popsicle stick to the back of the lid
- Tie a piece of yarn (roughly 6-8 inches) to the popsicle stick and glue the other end to to the ping pong ball
