Rewarded with a Baby*


Materials:

- printer
- paper
- scissors
- glue
- something to color with (if using B&W template)

Instructions:


- Print template
- Color the template pieces
- Cut out the template pieces
- Assemble the pieces to create an angel
- TIP: precut the pieces and put each angel craft in a ziplock. Have the kids color and glue


The Life and Times of Jesus: A Star was Followed

Materials:





- printer,
- paper
- scissors.
- Optional: crayons (or paint, markers, etc)
- string, thread, ribbon or wool.

Instructions:

- Print template and color as desired.
- Cut out the template pieces (may require adult assistance and can be done before hand).
- Cut on one of the dotted line right up to the center.
- Pick out the two matching stars (this is good practice for young children!).
- Slide the stars together, top to bottom all I have is the snowflake image to show you how it's done.
- Glue a ribbon or thread onto the top (or hole punch a small hole and tie a ribbon through (I used a thread and it worked really well).

The Life and Times of Jesus: Jesus is Baptized

Materials:

- white paper
- pencil or marker
- orange marker or scrap of orange construction paper
- scissors
- Single hole punch
- string/rope

Instructions:

- Place hand on white paper with fingers squeezed together and thumb extended as far as possible
- Trace around hand
- Use marker or pencil to draw on a small wing and eye
- Cut small orange beak and glue on thumb part below eye
- Cut out, punch hole and thread string or rope on for hanging

The Life and Times of Jesus: The Miracles of Jesus – Lazarus

Materials:

- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Paper or Styrofoam cups
- Markers or decorating materials
- Glue or tape
- Toilet Paper tube or popsicle stick
- Felt or cloth

Instructions:

- Decorate the tube with a “face” like Lazarus.
- Wrap the tube with cloth or paper strips, to be “mummified” and glue or tape them securely.
- Decorate the cup with rock colors or “tomb-like” decorations. Cut a slit into it as a stone opening.
- Place the “Lazarus” inside the cup “tomb.”
- Add a verse caption and enjoy making Lazarus come out of his tomb!


The Life and Times of Jesus: Jesus' Greatest Gift to Us All

Materials:

- Wool or ribbon
- single hole punch
- scissors
- pencil
- card stock, poster board or construction paper

Instructions:

- ADULT: print template of choice or make your own.
- ADULT: Glue onto a thick piece of cardboard (cardboard backs from paper pads or old boxes work well).
- ADULT: Cut out this template .
- Allow the children to trace the template onto a piece of card stock or poster board (or construction paper... Though I prefer the thicker card stock for lacing projects).
OR have an adult do this prior to craft time.
- Allow the children to cut out their card stock shapes
OR have an adult do this prior to craft time.
- Allow the children to make holes around their shape (about an inch or two apart)
OR have an adult do this prior to craft time.
- Provide the children with a length of wool or ribbon.
 - You can wrap some scotch tape around the end of the wool to make it more like a shoe lace.
 - Have the child thread the wool through the holes.
- Practice tying knots and/or bows to tie off in the center.
- Optional: Let the children use stickers to further decorate their completed project.
